The American Legion Community Band recently lost one of our longtime members. Dr. Donald McNeill passed away in September 2019. Don played first chair clarinet in the band since our founding in 1985, until about 2 years ago when he retired from the band due to health issues.

Don was highly regarded in the Front Royal area as a musician, where for decades he played a leading role in musical activities such as local jazz groups and the hospital follies.

Don was a physician in Front Royal for many years in private practice, in the emergency room at Warren Memorial Hospital, and later for several businesses and organizations locally, including at Randolph-Macon Academy where he was the school doctor. He also served as a volunteer at Saint Luke's Clinic and at Warren Memorial Hospital.

Our upcoming "Fall Benefit Concert" is dedicated to our good friend and fellow musician, Dr. Don McNeill. We hope many of Don's friends will come and honor his memory.
